## **1** Grammar Review

**Aims:** To review and practise the past perfect simple, past perfect continuous, *used to* and *would*. This can be completed when students have finished the unit.

Time: 15-20 minutes

**Materials:** 1 handout for each group of three or four students. You will also need a dice and counters.

- Divide students into groups of three or four. Give them a copy of the board game, a dice and counters. Tell them to place the counters on START HERE.
- The first student rolls the dice, moves their counter and completes the task on the square. If they can't do the task, or they make a mistake, they go back three spaces.
- In the Talk about squares, give your students a minimum time (e.g. 1 minute) that they have to talk for.
- The winner is the first person to the FINISH square, or the person on the highest number when you stop the game.
- If students are finding questions 4 and 11 difficult, you can give extra clues. For example, tell them the last word in the sentence, or give them the first three words in the sentence.
