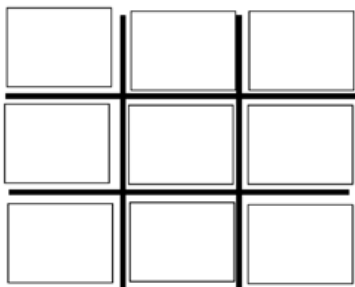
9 Grammar Review

Aims: To review and practise grammar from the unit. This can be completed when students have finished the unit.

Time: 15–20 minutes

Materials: 1 set of cards cut up for each pair of students

- Divide students into pairs. Give each pair a set of cards. Then tell students to draw a noughts and crosses grid on a piece of paper. Each square of the grid should be the same size as the cards. Students shuffle the cards and put one card face down on each square.



- Students now play noughts and crosses together. They take it in turns to select a square, turn over the card and do the task on the card. If they do the task correctly, they can put a nought (O) or a cross (X) on the grid. If they make a mistake, they return the card to the grid and their partner can take a turn. The aim of the game is to make a row – diagonally, horizontally or vertically – of three noughts or three crosses.
