



### **LEARN THIS!** Present perfect

We use the present perfect:

- a to give news, when we do not say exactly when the event happened. Guess what? I've won a competition!
- **b** to talk about events during a period of time (e.g. a holiday) that is still continuing. I'm in Paris. I've visited a museum but I haven't seen the Eiffel Tower.
- c to ask how long a situation has existed. How long have you been in Spain?
- d with for or since to say how long a situation has existed. We use for with a period of time and since to say when it started.

We've been in Spain for a week / since Tuesday.

We often use been (instead of gone) as the past participle of go. It means the person has gone and come back.

She's been to a museum. (She's now back at the hotel.)

She's gone to a museum. (She's still there.)
