

RULE FOR MAKING QUESTION:

When we are making a yes/no questions, we put the verb «be» at the beginning of a sentence.

EXAMPLE:

Sentence: He is from England.

Question Sentence: Is he from England?


SHORT - LONG ANSWER FORMS:

Question Answer (Short -Long)
