



RULE FOR MAKING QUESTION:

When we are making a yes/no questions, we put the verb «be» at the beginning of a sentence.

EXAMPLE:

● Sentence: He is from England.

● Question Sentence: Is he from England?

SHORT - LONG ANSWER FORMS:

Question

Am I sympathetic?

Answer (Short -Long)

Yes. / Yes, you are. / Yes, you are sympathetic.

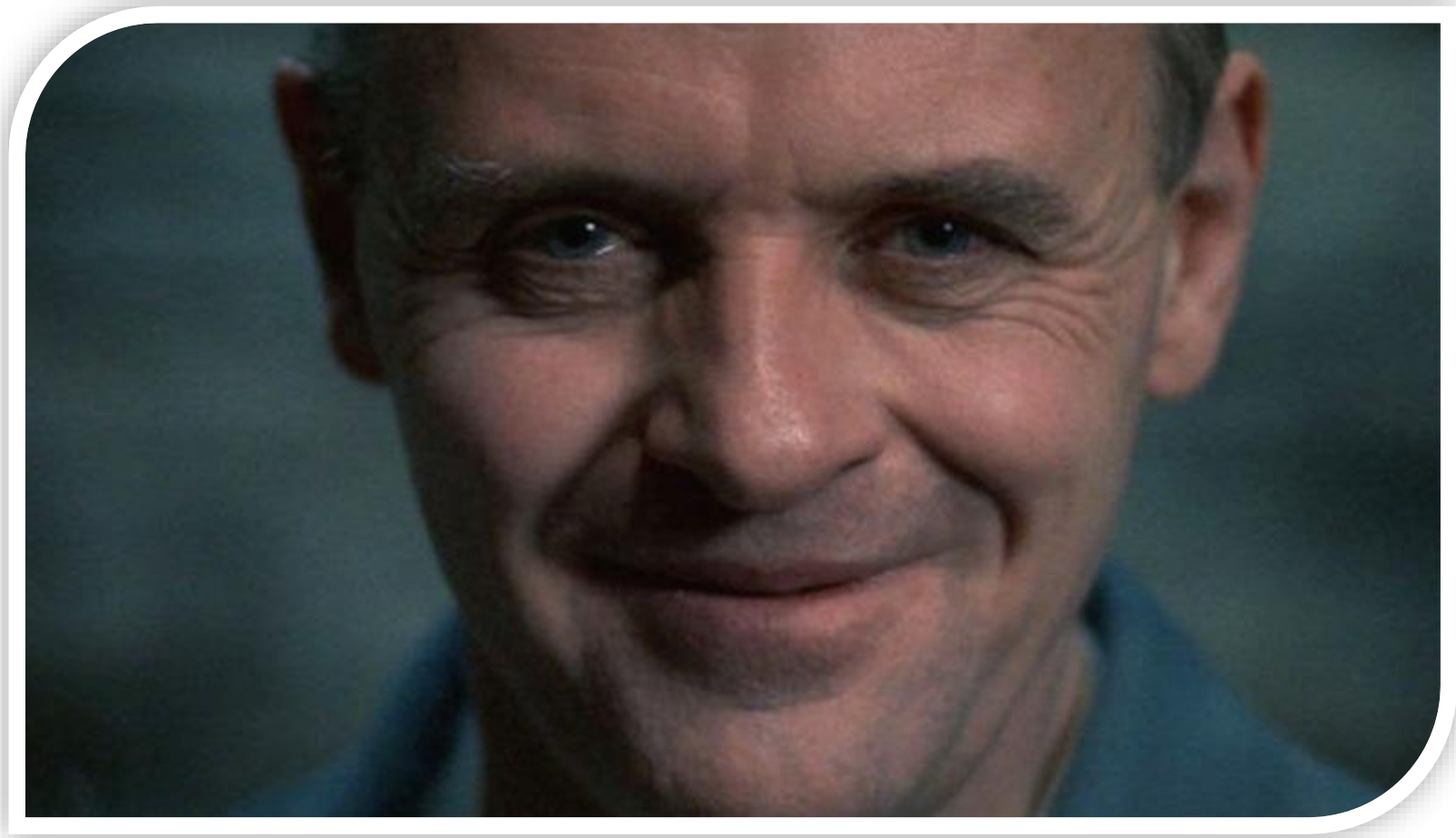
